Adrian Walmsley is Vice Chairman of the Police Authority. He joined the Authority in April 2009. He is Vice Chairman of Staff Committee and is a member of Audit, Finance, Selection and Remuneration Committees and the Police Authority Improvement Panel. Adrian is lead Member for Professional Standards and the Chester Inner and Outer Neighbourhood Policing Units.

Adrian is a Councillor for Cheshire West & Chester Council and also serves as Chairman of the Council's Finance & Resources Policy Board. Prior to this, he was a member of the former Chester City Council Cabinet serving as the Executive Member for Resources.

Adrian retired from full time employment in June 2008 having spent his career in the public and private sectors in the arena of Industrial Relations, Human Resources and Employment Law. Latterly, Adrian was the Regional Manager for the Engineering Employers' Federation covering the entire North Wales/Cheshire area.
