

Anne Doran – Independent Member

Anne joined Cheshire Police Authority as an independent Member in 2003. She is Vice Chairman of the Performance & Service Improvement Panel and is a member of Audit and Engagement Committees. Anne serves on Police Appeals Tribunals, the North West Air Support Consortium Management Committee, Sub-regional Stakeholders Forum, North-West Joint Committee and is the lead Member for Estates Management and the Winsford Neighbourhood Policing Unit. Anne is also an inspector of police dog welfare.

Anne worked for social services for 35 years, starting out as a social worker and moving on to become a senior manager specialising in learning disabilities and mental health. She is involved in mental health review tribunals and disability living appeals. She sits on Fitness to Practice Panels for the Health Professions Council and was a magistrate for 18 years.

Since joining the Police Authority, Anne has been involved in the Best Value Review for victim and witness support. She was lead member for the Taking Control programme which included the development of neighbourhood policing and reorganisation of the Constabulary.

She would like the Constabulary to continue to focus on Neighbourhood Policing and improve the way that officers communicate and feedback to the public.
