21. POLICE REGULATIONS 2003 AND CONSTABULARY BUSINESS INTEREST PROCEDURE: BUSINESS INTEREST APPEALS

The Clerk & Chief Executive advised Members that pursuant to Regulation 7 of the Police Regulations 2003, the Committee were required to determine an appeal by two police officers against a decision by the Chief Constable relating to business interests. In accordance with the Constabulary's Business Interest Procedure, the Committee were also required to determine an appeal by a member of police staff against a decision of the Chief Constable relating to a business interest.

Members considered in detail the representations submitted by the police officers, the member of police staff and the Director of Human Resources, on behalf of the Chief Constable.

RESOLVED: That

- (1) the decision of the Director of Human Resources, on behalf of the Chief Constable, in relation to the appeal submitted by the two police officers as detailed in Appendix 1 to the Clerk & Chief Executive's Report, be upheld; and
- (2) the decision of the Director of Human Resources, on behalf of the Chief Constable, in relation to the appeal by the member of police staff, as detailed in Appendix 2 to the Clerk & Chief Executive's Report, be upheld.
