

Terry Savage – Independent Member

Terry joined Cheshire Police Authority as an independent member in April 2007. He is Vice Chairman of Engagement Committee and a member of Audit, Staff, and Standards Committees. Terry is the Authority's lead Member for Human Rights and Health & Safety. Terry Facilitates the Authority's Police Question Time public consultation events, is the Chairman of Cheshire CrimeBeat, lead Member for Winsford Neighbourhood Policing Unit and an inspector of police dog welfare.

Before joining Cheshire Police Authority, Terry was employed by the Union of Shop, Distributive and Allied Workers (USDAW). He began his Career with USDAW as a shop steward and went on to become a full time official with regional responsibility.

He was a member of the former industrial tribunals panel from 1977 to 1983 and was appointed National Officer of the trade union in 1989. He retired from the USDAW in 2003.

Terry is a non-executive director of the Central and Eastern Cheshire Primary Care Trust and is Chairman of the Cheshire East Community Health. He has also been Chairman of Winsford United FC.

Having been a victim of crime and with a personal interest in neighbourhood policing, Terry wanted to join Cheshire Police Authority as he believes that 'in order to have an influence you have to be part of it.' Terry is keen to get involved in neighbourhood policing in Cheshire to help support and secure its continued development.
